### The Silent Witness Story

In 2021, 49 South Carolinians were killed by their intimate partners. As citizens of this state, we have a responsibility to take a stand against this injustice. Therefore, in 1998 our state joined with more than 40 other states in a mission "to promote peace, healing and responsibility in adult relationships."

25th annual Silent Witness During the wooden silhouettes ceremony, represent women and men who have died in 2021 due to domestic violence. This year, there are 50 silhouettes: 37 are for the known female homicide victims, 12 are for the known male victims, and represents those victims of whom we are unaware.
